

Each evening you can help your child at home by doing the following:

### Cut-Up Sentence

1. Listen to your child read the complete sentence that they have printed on the envelope. If she/he has forgotten the sentence, tell your child the sentence and have your child repeat it.)
2. Watch your child put the cut up pieces back into the correct order. She/he may do this with or without the envelope as a guide.
3. After the sentence is put back together, ask your child to check it against the sentence on the envelope to make sure it is correct and have your child read it to you.
4. Please do not use the words as flash cards or expect your child to read the words without the entire sentence being present.
5. Have your child trace the word with a pencil and then write the word. This is a word we are working on knowing.

### Book Reading

Please listen to your child read her/his little book(s). If she/he has trouble with a word she/he will use pictures or beginning sounds for a clue.
